How to use it

How to install it to your path

- ▶ Place the contents within your TEXINPUTS path.
- ► On Linux, modify the TEXINPUTS variable to point to the directory where these files exist.
- ► For example: export TEXINPUTS=\${HOME}/LaTeX//:\${TEXINPUTS}
- ▶ On MacTeX, you need to install it to \${HOME}/Library/texmf
- ► If you have admin permission copy it to your TEX tree to the directory where the other beamer themes are located e.g. /usr/share/texmf-texlive/tex/latex/beamer/themes
- ► To use the theme, add the command \usetheme{lehigh} to the preamble of your document.
- Compile using pdflatex to get the pdf file.
- ▶ Feel free to modify the theme to suit your needs.
- ▶ NO, I won't modify the theme for your needs.
