How to install it to your path

- ▶ Place the contents within your TEXINPUTS path.
- ▶ On Linux, modify the TEXINPUTS variable to point to the directory where these files exist.
- ▶ For example: `export TEXINPUTS=${HOME}/LaTeX//:${TEXINPUTS}`
- ▶ On MacTeX, you need to install it to `${HOME}/Library/texmf`
- ▶ If you have admin permission copy it to your T_EX tree to the directory where the other beamer themes are located e.g.
`/usr/share/texmf-texlive/tex/latex/beamer/themes`
- ▶ To use the theme, add the command `\usetheme{lehigh}` to the preamble of your document.
- ▶ Compile using `pdflatex` to get the pdf file.
- ▶ Feel free to modify the theme to suit your needs.
- ▶ NO, I won't modify the theme for your needs.
